 - B. Currently run through in-house public relations but not open to outside outlets
 - C. Mention of Elliott Neff invited to upcoming tournament
 - i. arrangement made with PSD to beta-test his software (Chess For Life)
 - ii. gives WECC another year to raise funds to cover the cost of interested
 - iii. coaches training required to utilize software, give feedback to Elliott
 - iv. students who have used to software seem to really like it
 - v. WECC wanted to coordinate with him related to 2018 WSECC
 - vi. offer him a comped room at the Hampton, invited his more advanced students, as well as a celebrity, if possible, associated with the Queen of Katwi
 - D. Asked Jose what assistance is needed for tournament
 - i. registration number currently at 168
 - ii. Edith has determined to number of place settings for trophies
 - iii. she is also considering where to locate each section
 - iv. David M. and Doug will be present, as well as Mike Wilbricht and Adam Kornbaugh
 - v. Edith has a number of parents in mind to help

- vi. any word from Cathy to help with pairings? She can make it.
- a. David M. will pick her up at 7:40 am for check-in at 8 am vii. Jose will take care of pairings for at least one section, if not all viii. David M. will also ask Bill about pairings
- 5. Review Kings Gambit Tournament preparations
 - A. Edith will be bringing students from PSD
 - i. 7-12 paid for out of PSD budget, WECC still provides invoice
 - ii. K-6 responsible for paying themselves
 - B. Aimee Kovis curious about the size of tournament they can expect
 - i. Okay with smaller tournament
 - C. David M. needs to create an invoice for PSD for 7-8 & 9-12 Teams (one invoice 7-12)
 - D. Queen's Element Tournament
 - i. Sections to include K-3 under 800 and 4-6 under 800 and K-3 open and
 - 4-6 open to get more kids to qualify for State
 - ii. wait to open registration until a flyer is available
- 6. Review WSECC proposal to include 7-8 MS Tournament in 2018
 - A. Dawn Johnson really wants middle schools to be included in State tournament
 - i. Contacted Rick Jorgensen, who has specific ideas for it to work
 - ii. Comp room, up to \$600 for expenses and up to \$600 for trophies
 - B. Rick expects 150 kids, along with PSD middle schoolers
 - C. Stan expressed concerns about space issues and other logistical problems
 - D. Executive room set aside for top 32 kids (over 1500) along with middle players (1100-1500) and open section playing on floor
 - E. TRAC has approximately # available (Stan has precise number in notes)
- 7. Review Proposed LOGO for WSECC (see attached)
 - A. Stan commented on how size of chess pieces looked off
 - B. David M. and Stan liked the same logo, except for the wording, and all present agree on the same
 - C. Change wording to "Visit / Tri-Cities / Washington Elementary Chess Championship
 - D. Develop flyers to share at 2017 State tournament, so those present know what to expect in 2018
 - E. May 7th, 2017 as early as you can sign up for a room
- 8. Report on assignments
 - A. Stan has new computer
 - B. David M. provided printout of hotel rates
 - i. Hampton Inn offered very reasonable rates, especially for second night, to average \$99 over two nights
 - C. David M. provided D-U-N-S Number: 071854789 UBI #: 602252105
 - D. Dawn Johnson eager to help with fund-raising for State
 - E. Media exposure considered important for upcoming events to spread the word

- 9. Assign tasks for follow up
 - A. David M. will lay out tables and chairs for team tables
 - B. Present that to TRAC to verify they can support it
 - C. Formalize 7-8 tournament by next meeting, have Rick sign that proposal
 - D. 750 players is manageable, up to 1000 gets tight
 - E. That many means up to 2000 chairs in team table room
 - F. Can accommodate 32 players in hotel
 - G. Leaves 24 middle players without a place to play, without being exposed to noise from other players playing on a different schedule
 - H. Stan will talk to Holiday Inn Express about getting 3rd conference room for Saturday (at no charge)
 - I. Stan will contact Dawn about Battelle/corporate sponsorship
 - i. what is WECC willing to do for primary sponsor?
 - ii. Present flyers at 2017 State with corporate sponsor logo in prominent place
