- 1. Welcome advisory counsel! Hi Edith!
- 2. Review minutes for 7/14/21
  - A. Alex moved to approve minutes as read, Danielle seconded, all said "Aye"
- 3. State Discussion 2023
  - A. Need to prepare
    - i. TRAC deposit down?
- 4. Hanford tournament coordinated
  - A. K-8 tournament
    - i. High schoolers judge and assist elsewhere
  - B. Makes for no K-12 tourney in February
    - i. Should find workarounds all right
    - ii. Volunteer hours found for judges
  - C. Mike will also submit taxes and renew insurance
    - i. As part of a typical "consent agenda"
    - ii. Cost of business as usual
  - D. Alex asked about CDs maturing
    - i. Nothing coming up of importance
    - ii. Need to pay attention for 4yr maturity
      - 1. Decide whether or not we want to liquidate
- 5. Old Business
  - A. Tournament Schedule
    - i. Danielle has some updates
      - 1. Schedule features black spots, waiting to hear back from potential hosts
      - 2. Orchard will NOT host
    - ii. Edith would like to move Frozen Knights up one week, Dec. 11th
      - 1. Done!
    - iii. Tri-Cities Prep a done deal
    - iv. Hanford High wants to re-start chess club
      - 1. Anxious to host a tournament this year
        - a. Grace Deng and Ken Hou a motivating force
        - b. Agreement to give spot to first group to ask
        - c. ASB organization one we can work with
    - v. State tournament scheduled for April 30<sup>th</sup> at Tacoma Convention Center
      - 1. Still working out details, plans for sections
        - a. How to accommodate middle and high school
    - vi. Post schedule in August after we sort out Hanford
    - vii. Do we have a solid sense of circumstances to be expected
      - 1. Remains to be determined
        - a. So far as masking, distancing, etc.
    - viii. Mike concerned about volunteer participation

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- 1. Wants to try to incorporate that in tentative schedule in order to lock down TD in particular, as well as judges, scorekeepers
- ix. Alex suggested handing the Richland Rook Roundup baton to Hanford
  - Contains a certain poetry with Cathy involved at Hanford/started tournament, many of the players started at Lewis & Clark
    - a. Reach out, see what they think
- 6. New Business
  - A. Revisit by-laws
    - i. Term limits
    - ii. Non-discrimination statement
      - 1. Borrow from local school district
        - a. Consideration for marginalized groups
      - 2. Danielle will look into such a statement and report next mtng
  - B. New shirt order
    - i. Danielle can look into options
      - 1. Report back with pricing choices
  - C. Return to revisitation of by-laws
    - i. Dave approved inclusion of term limits
      - 1. Not necessarily considered new business
    - ii. Review of existing by-laws
      - 1. 3-year term
        - a. At conclusion of 1st term, may complete another
      - 2. Staggering the officers terms
        - a. To avoid all officers' terms ending at same time
        - b. A graph would work to illustrate this overlap
          - i. Danielle will devise a chart to show these terms
            - 1. Tracking purposes
        - c. Dave's term to last 3 years after approval of these terms
        - d. Mike considering an end to his term as Treasurer
          - i. Don't want to leave during State responsibilities
            - 1. Possibly the year prior
  - D. Need to update website
    - i. Perhaps by Fall, after other details settled
